## **Bulk & Bundled Brush**

Bulky waste will be collected weekly, on your trash collection day.

You are limited to two cubic yards of bulky waste per collection.

Place all bulk items next to your trash cart no later than 7:00 am on your designated trash pickup day.

One cubic yard is equivalent to approximately one washing machine.

## Bulky Waste - Acceptable

Toys and Yard Tools Tagged as "Bulk Item"

Furniture

**Bundled Carpet in 4-foot Lengths** 

Fence Panels No Larger than 4'x6'

**Bagged Leaves** 

Washing Machines, Dryers, Water Heaters and Kitchen Appliances

Refrigerators/Freezers (Must be tagged certifying removal of refrigerants)

### **Bulky Waste - Prohibited**

Single Items Weighing More than 150 Pounds

**Commercial Remodeling/Construction Debris** 

Household Hazardous Waste (Includes paint, aerosols, motor oil, etc.)

**Tires, Batteries, and Propane Tanks** 

**Household Trash** 

Loose Brush

Loose Debris (Debris must be placed in a box or other container no larger than 2'x2'x4' and weigh no more than 50 pounds.)

ALL GASOLINE MUST BE REMOVED FROM ENGINES.

#### ALL BRUSH MUST BE TIED AND BUNDLED and may be set out in UNLIMITED QUANTITIES.

Tied and bundled brush cannot exceed 4' x 2' or weigh more than 50 pounds per bundle.



#### NO LOOSE BRUSH WILL BE ACCEPTED.

## **HHW & Used Electronics**

Household Hazardous Waste & Used Electronics Door-side Collection



CWD's Door-side Collection program encourages safe, easy, and responsible disposal of approved household hazardous waste and electronics.

Items accepted via the HHW Door-side Collection program include poison, solvent, oil-based and latex paint, aerosols, used motor oil, auto batteries, fluorescent tubes, and flat screen televisions (no Cathode Ray Tubes).

#### To schedule your monthly collection:

- 1. Call CWD at 972.392.9300/Option 2.
- 2. CWD will mail you a collection kit.
- 3. Assemble your HHW and used electronics according to the instructions provided.
- 4. Place your HHW and used electronics at your doorstep by 7:00 am on your service day, where CWD will pick it up.

## **Trash & Recycling Services**

TRASH WILL BE COLLECTED ONCE A WEEK.

RECYCLING WILL BE COLLECTED EVERY OTHER WEEK.

Please see the map to the right to determine the pickup day for your residence. Place all items out no later than 7:00 am on your pickup day for service between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm.

All TRASH must be placed in bags inside the GREY 95-gallon trash cart.

All RECYCLABLES must be empty, clean, and dry, and placed LOOSELY inside the BLUE 95-gallon recycle cart. DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES.

Please ensure the trash cart and the recycle cart are separated by at least three feet, and three feet away from obstacles such as mailboxes, cars, fences, gas meters, and drainage ditches. Position the carts with the wheels toward the residence.
