Bulky Waste & Brush

Bulky waste and brush will be collected on the first Thursday of the month. You are limited to two (2) cubic yards of bulky waste and loose brush per month. Tied and bundled brush may be set out in unlimited quantities.

Place all bulky waste and brush items next to your trash receptacle no later than 7:00 am on your designated trash pickup day.

1 cubic yard is equivalent to the size of approximately 1 washing machine.



Bulky Waste - Acceptable

- Toys and Yard Tools Tagged as "Bulk Item"
- Furniture
- Bundled Carpet in 4-foot Lengths
- Fence Panels No Larger than 4'x6'
- Washing Machines, Dryers, Water Heaters and Kitchen Appliances
- Refrigerators/Freezers (Must be tagged certifying removal of refrigerants)
- Additional Trash Bags

Bulky Waste - Prohibited

- Single Items Weighing More than 150 Pounds
- Commercial Construction and Remodeling Debris
- Concrete, Rock, Stone, Etc.
- Household Hazardous Waste
- Tires, Batteries, and Propane Tanks
- Loose Debris (Debris must be placed in heavy duty bags or in boxes or other containers no larger than 2'x2'x4' that weigh no more than 50 pounds.)

To schedule your bulky waste and brush pickup, please call 972.392.9300/Option 2, before 5:00 pm on the Wednesday prior to the first Thursday of the month.

Brush

Tree limbs must be placed with trunks parallel to the street without obstructing the sidewalk. Individual items or bundles must weigh less than 50 lbs., and be no longer than four (4) feet.

Trash & Recycling Services

 TRASH WILL BE COLLECTED
ONCE A WEEK on THURSDAY.

All TRASH must be placed inside the GREY 95-gallon trash cart. Please ensure the lid is closed.

Please place all items out no later than 7:00 am on your pickup day for service between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm.

Please ensure the trash cart and the **recycle cart** are separated by at least three (3) feet, and three (3) feet away from obstacles such as mailboxes, fences, gas meters, and drainage ditches. Position the carts with the wheels toward the residence.

Automated Side Load (ASL) trucks must have adequate space in the street or alleyway for the truck to line up to a cart and allow for the truck's arm and claw to extend to retrieve the cart. In order to protect your property, the driver will not service your cart(s) if vehicles or other obstacles are positioned too close to the cart(s).

 RECYCLING WILL BE COLLECTED
ONCE A WEEK on THURSDAY.

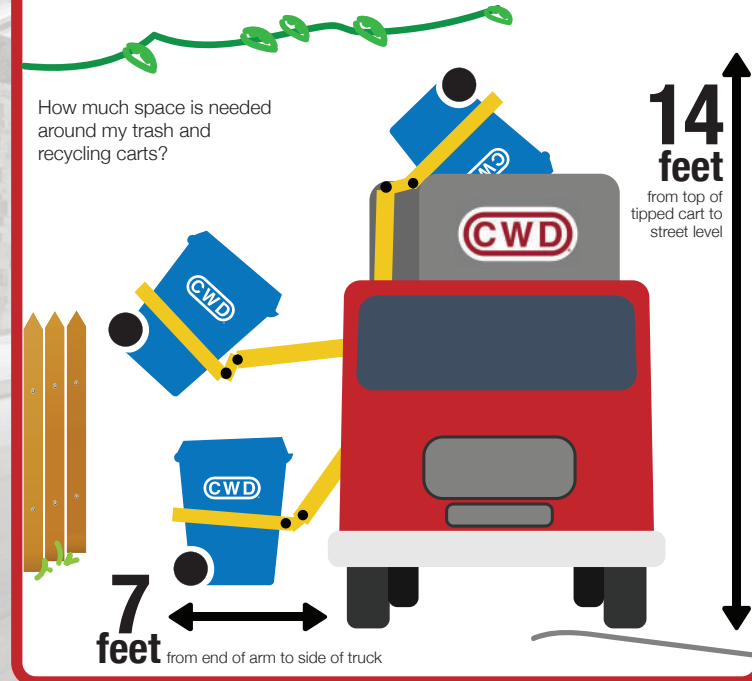
All **RECYCLABLES** must be empty, clean, and dry prior to being placed loosely inside the **BLUE** 95-gallon recycle cart.

Take a minute to think about what you're throwing in your trash.

PLAY IT SAFE!

- BATTERIES** contain heavy metals and can even start fires in garbage trucks.
- ELECTRONICS** contain heavy metals and chemicals that contaminate soil and water.
- PAINTS/STAINS** contain toxic solvents and other chemicals.
- CHEMICALS** and other household poisons require safe disposal.
- LIGHT BULBS** of the fluorescent and high-energy discharge varieties can release mercury.
- ENGINE OIL** from a single oil change can contaminate one million gallons of fresh water.
- FLAMMABLE ITEMS** can cause fires in garbage trucks, dumpsters, and landfills.

PLEASE RECYCLE THESE ITEMS

- Plastic Containers #1 - 5 & #7 (No Styrofoam)
- Aluminum, Steel & Tin Containers
- Glass Bottles & Containers
- Wax-Coated Paper Drink Containers
- Corrugated Cardboard & Boxboard
- Newspaper
- Mixed Paper

DO NOT RECYCLE THESE ITEMS

- Plastic Bags
- Packaging Materials
- Styrofoam
- Food or Wet Waste
- Paper Towels/Toilet Tissue
- Leaves, Grass Clippings, and Branches
- Shredded Paper
- Lightbulbs/Window Panes
- Paper and Plastic
