## Bulky Waste & Brush

Bulky waste will be  
collected every other  
month, according to the  
schedule below.

1 cubic yard is equivalent  
to approximately one  
washing machine.



You are limited to 12 cubic  
yards of bulky waste and  
brush per collection.

Tree limbs must be placed with trunks parallel  
to the street without obstructing the sidewalk.  
Individual items or bundles must weigh less  
than 50 pounds, and be no longer than 10 feet.

Place all bulk and brush items at your curb no  
later than 7:00 a.m. on the Monday of your  
service week.

## Bulky Waste - Acceptable

Toys and Yard Tools Tagged  
as "Bulk Item"

Furniture

Bundled Carpet in 4-foot Lengths

Fence Panels No Larger than 4'x6'

Thorny Vines Must be Bagged or in Containers

Bagged Leaves (10 Bag Limit)

Washing Machines, Dryers, Water Heaters  
and Kitchen Appliances

Refrigerators/Freezers  
(Must be tagged certifying removal of refrigerants)


## Bulky Waste - Prohibited

Commercial Remodeling/Construction Debris

Household Hazardous Waste

Tires, Batteries, and Propane Tanks

Loose Household Debris  
(Debris must be placed in a box or other  
container no larger than 2'x2'x4' and  
weighing no more than 50 pounds.)



Not your service month? You may drop off up to 12 cubic yards of bulky waste and brush at the CWD Transfer Station, 2010 California Crossing Road, Dallas, TX 75220. We are open the first Saturday of every month, excluding holidays, 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. A copy of your current water bill is required. Charges apply to volumes in excess of 12 cubic yards.



# TRASH&RECYCLE

-  TRASH WILL BE COLLECTED  
ONCE A WEEK.
-  RECYCLING WILL BE COLLECTED  
ONCE A WEEK.

Please see the map below to determine the pickup day for your residence. Place all items out no later than 7:00 a.m. on your pickup day for service between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.



All **TRASH** must be placed in bags inside the **GREY** 95-gallon trash cart.

All **RECYCLABLES** must be empty, clean, and dry, and placed **LOOSELY** inside the **BLUE** 95-gallon recycle cart. **DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES.**

Please ensure the trash cart and the **recycle cart** are separated by at least three feet, and three feet away from obstacles such as mailboxes, cars, fences, gas meters, and drainage ditches. Position the carts where the driveway meets the street, keeping them at least three feet apart with wheels toward the residence.

-  Plastic Containers #1-5 & #7
-  Milk Cartons & Juice Boxes
-  Corrugated Cardboard & Boxboard
-  Aluminum, Steel, & Tin Containers
-  Glass Bottles & Containers
-  Mixed Paper, Newspaper, etc.

## DO NOT RECYCLE

Always **EMPTY, CLEAN, & DRY** and **LOOSE IN THE CART**

- Plastic Bags**  
*They tangle recycling equipment.*
- Packaging Materials**  
**Styrofoam**  
**Food or Wet Waste**  
*These belong in the trash.*
- Paper Towels/Toilet Tissue**  
**Bagged Leaves, Grass Clippings, and Branches**  
**Lightbulbs/Window Panes**  
*Items constructed of multiple materials are not accepted.*
- Shredded Paper**  
*The small pieces get caught in recycling equipment.*
- Paper & Plastic Food Serving Items**  
*These items are not recyclable for many reasons, including probable food contamination and cutlery size.*
