Trash & Recycling

Trash and recycling will be picked up weekly, on Wednesday. Place all items out no later than 7:00 a.m. on your pickup day for service between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

All TRASH must be placed in bags inside the GREY 95-gallon trash cart. A maximum of five additional sealed trash bags will be collected if set beside the cart.

All RECYCLABLES must be empty, clean, and dry, and placed LOOSELY inside the BLUE 95-gallon recycle cart. DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES.

Please ensure the trash cart and the recycle cart are separated by at least three feet, and three feet away from obstacles such as mailboxes, cars, fences, gas meters, and drainage ditches. Position the carts with the wheels toward the residence.

Bulky Waste & Brush

Bulky waste and brush will be collected on your regular trash pickup days. You are limited to four cubic yards of bulky waste and loose brush per collection. Tied and bundled brush may be set out in unlimited quantities.

1 cubic yard is equivalent to 1 washing machine



Place all bulky waste and brush items next to, and at least three feet from, your trash receptacle no later than 7:00 a.m. on your trash pickup day.



Have a load that exceeds the acceptable limit? Want it all picked up at once? Please contact CWD for a price quote.

Brush

Tree limbs must be placed with trunks parallel to the street without obstructing the sidewalk. Individual items or bundles must weigh less than 50 lbs., and be no longer than 10 feet.



Bulky Waste - Acceptable

Toys and Yard Tools Tagged as "Bulk Item"
Furniture
Bundled Carpet in 4-foot Lengths
Fence Panels No Larger than 4'x6'
Washers, Dryers, Water Heaters, and Kitchen Appliances
Refrigerators/Freezers (Tagged certifying removal of refrigerants)
Additional Trash Bags

Bulky Waste - Prohibited

Single Items Weighing More than 150 Pounds
Commercial Construction and Remodeling Debris
Household Hazardous Waste
Tires, Batteries, and Propane Tanks
Loose Debris (Debris must be placed in a box or other container no larger than 2'x2'x4' and weigh no more than 50 pounds.)

HHW & Used Electronics

Residents are eligible for door-side pickup of household hazardous waste (HHW) and used electronics. Contact CWD for details!
