Bundled Brush

Tied & Bundled Brush

Tied and bundled brush will be collected, **in unlimited quantities**, on Mondays and Thursdays.

Tied and bundled brush must weigh less than 50 lbs., and be **no longer than** four feet.

What about small twigs and acorns?



Small, hard-to-bundle yard waste items can be placed directly into your trash bag or in a brown craft paper bag. These items will be thrown out with the trash.

For **LOOSE BRUSH** or **BULK** collection, please call the Town of Addison at 972.450.2871.



Do NOT throw grease down the drain!

POUR grease into container. Let it SOLIDIFY. COVER IT and put it in the trash.

TRASH & RECYCLE

 TRASH WILL BE COLLECTED ON MONDAY AND THURSDAY.

 RECYCLING WILL BE COLLECTED ON MONDAY.



Place all items out no later than 7:00 a.m. on your pickup day for service between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

All household TRASH must be set out in disposable bags or boxes. Tied bags may be placed in a customer-owned can or cart.

All RECYCLABLES must be empty, clean, and dry, and placed LOOSELY inside the BLUE 95-gallon recycle cart.

DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES.

Please ensure the trash bags and the recycle cart are separated by at least three feet, and three feet away from obstacles such as mailboxes, cars, fences, gas meters, and drainage ditches. Position the cart where the driveway meets the street with wheels toward the residence.

Completely close cart lid.

Do not place cart on grass.



PLEASE LEAVE AT LEAST

3 FEET

Take a minute to think about what you're throwing in your trash.

PLAY IT SAFE!

BATTERIES

contain heavy metals and can even start fires in garbage trucks.

ELECTRONICS

contain heavy metals and chemicals that contaminate soil and water.

PAINTS/STAINS

contain toxic solvents and other chemicals.

CHEMICALS

and other household poisons require safe disposal.

LIGHT BULBS

of the fluorescent and high-energy discharge varieties can release mercury.

ENGINE OIL

from a single oil change can contaminate one million gallons of fresh water.

FLAMMABLE ITEMS

can cause fires in garbage trucks, dumpsters, and landfills.
